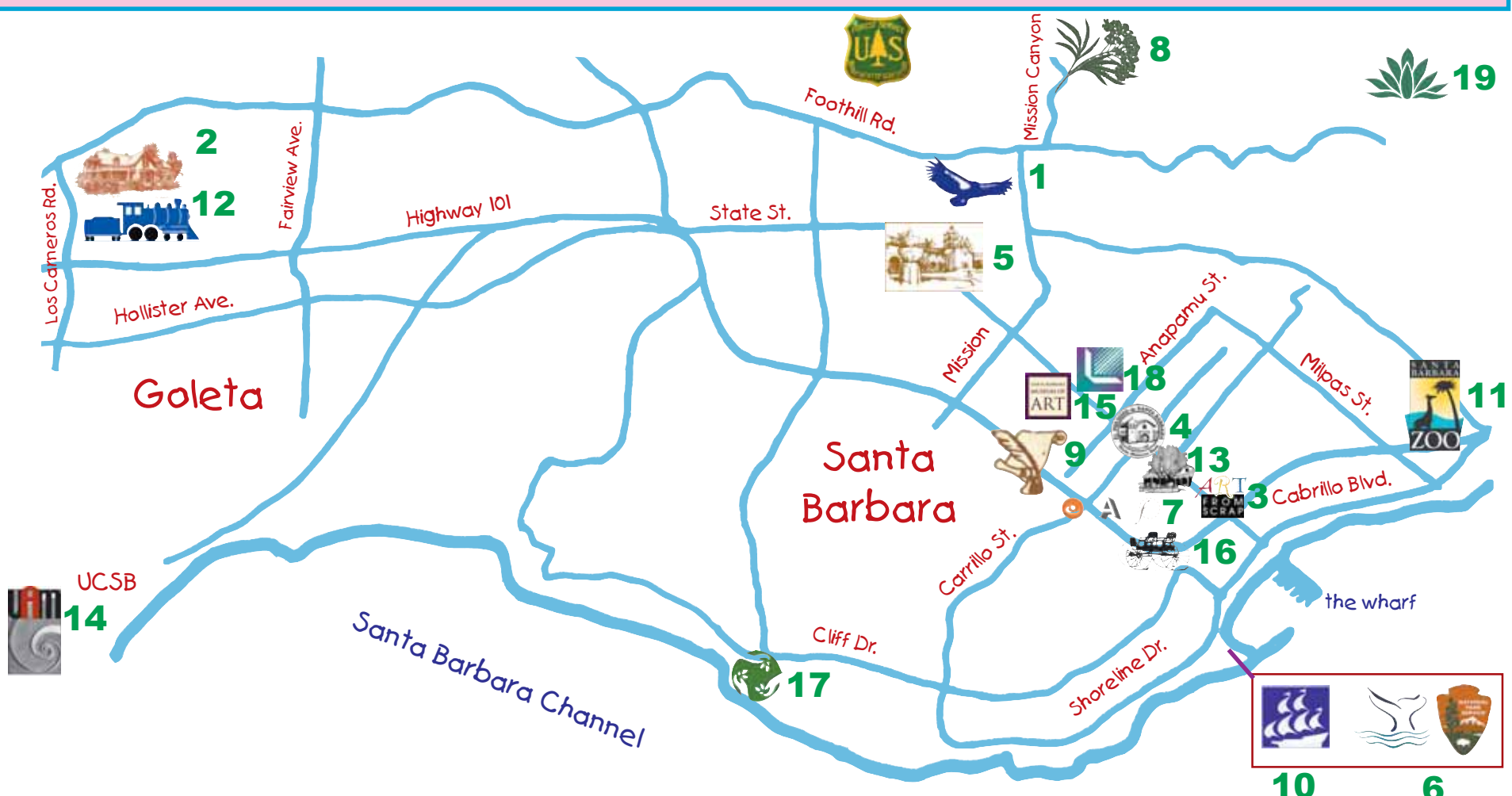
### Where in Santa Barbara?
